

Community Biodiversity Plan – Funding Received

- Background
 - Widespread Biodiversity loss
 - UN IPBES Global Assessment Report on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services, May 2019
 - 'catastrophic decline'
 - One million species threatened with extinction
 - human land requirement



Environment & Nature Fund

- Community Groups to develop a Community Biodiversity Plan
 - Based on expert recommendations: Ecologist
 - Collaborate with 3-5 land managers/owners
 - Classify local habitats, catalogue biodiversity, define suite actions to enhance biodiversity
 - Ecologist to submit collected data to National Biodiversity Data Centre

Community Biodiversity Plan

• Plan for 2020

- Public meeting to inform and engage with community (Thursday 13th February 2020)
- Ecologist to review selected sites in Spring & Autumn
- Link in with local Groups (e.g. Tidy Towns; Flower Club; Council; Schools)
- Workshop for Teachers, Grounds Keepers, Scout Leaders, etc.

- Progress Report due Dec 2020
- Community Biodiversity Plan due March 2021






